The EQ+ dashboard has five levels of data available:

- Process measures Includes multiple pages reporting at Region, ICS, Trust, Hospital Site levels. Data source: National Heart Failure Audit (NHFA) monthly data.
- Outcome measures Spells on discharge, length of stay, mortality and readmissions.

  Data source: Hospital Episode Statistics (HES) quarterly data.
- Alignment to track Best Practice
  Tariff (BPT) achievement, bespoke
  to each hospital Trust. Data
  Source: BPT quarterly data.
- Primary Care Heart Failure
  observed prevalence and
  treatment rates, reporting at ICS,
  CCG, PCN and Practice levels.
  Data source: Quality Outcomes
  Framework Data (QOF) annual data.
- Primary Care heart failure data fields extracted from GP systems.
